- **Shopping** Hesse St offers a wonderful array of shops from clothing and homewares to gourmet produce. You'll be sure to find something unique to take home or just enjoy browsing.
- Galleries and Antiques you'll find a range of art, antiques and collectables in Hesse St from the renowned Seaview Gallery to the Vintage Market Bazaar and more
- Cruises scenic day and sunset cruises leave from the Harbour

Food and Wine

- Cafes are plentiful in Hesse St treat yourself to a cooked breakfast or take a break from your shopping and enjoy a coffee and cake
- **Dining** there is a wide range of dining choice within walking distance of Banks from Fine Dining to a good counter meal at one of the nearby pubs
- Wineries, Farmgate and The Bellarine Taste Trail if you fancy a day out exploring the Bellarine by car you can visit the wineries and farmgates (blueberries, cheeses and olive oil to name a few), many of which are part of the Bellarine Taste Trail. - Citizens Park stroll a block away, along Stokes St, for a BBQ in this magnificent park. There are fabulous views of the bay, plenty of shade, space for the kids to play games and a 'cool' playground courtesy of the government stimulus package. There are toilet facilities in the park.
- **Beach** walking distance to two lovely beaches. The front beach is calm with an outlook across to Point Nepean and is ideal for very young children. The back beach stretches all the way to Point Lonsdale and provides swimming between the flags and rock pools to explore when the tide is out.
- Adventure Park Water Park halfway between Queenscliff and Geelong an entry fee into the park gives you unlimited use of rides and attractions. There are picnic tables in the gardens, gas bbq hire and shaded undercover marquees. Visit www.adventurepark.com.au for details.
- Ferry to Sorrento the ferry leaves every hour on the hour from 7am to 6pm from Wharf St, a short walk past the pier. It's a fun trip for kids with plenty to see and they may even spot some dolphins
- **Dining** the pubs are all very child-friendly offering kids meals and coloring books. The Esplanade also provides a sandpit out in the beer garden.

Walks/Sightseeing

- The Bellarine Rail Trail starts from the bottom of Hesse St at the Railway Station. A short walk along the trail will give you wonderful views of Swan Bay and its wildlife.
- **Beach** head to the top of Hesse St to get to the beach and you can walk along the beach all the way to Point Lonsdale. Watch the ships go out through the heads and on a clear day you can see across to Point Nepean.
- Train to Drysdale weekends and mid-week Tuesday and Thursday
- Visit the Harbour Precinct the Observation Tower has great views
- **Bikes** can be hired from Beacon Big 4 Resort popular rides are the Rail Trail and Point Lonsdale
